

\$1,000 Pre-Owned Electric Vehicle Incentive Q and A

Claiming Your Incentive

Q: How do I get the incentive?

A: Test drive an electric vehicle (EV) at the EV Discovery Centre or an EV Roadshow event, take the EV 101 seminar (approximately 1 hour) and buy a used EV within one year of taking the seminar to receive \$1,000 off your purchase. After taking the test drive AND attending the seminar, you will be emailed a digital certificate with a unique code. After buying your used EV, send the certificate, proof of purchase, proof of ownership and proof of insurance to usedEVincentive@plugndrive.ca. We will then process your claim.

Q: Can I purchase my used EV before I take the seminar and test drive?

A: Yes. Any used EV purchase made after April 14, 2019 is eligible for the incentive. You can complete the test drive and seminar components at any time.

Q: I have already test driven an electric car with Plug'n Drive. Do I have to test drive again?

A: No. You must still complete the seminar though.

Q: Which cars qualify?

A: Any used fully electric or plug-in hybrid electric car (not traditional gasoline/diesel hybrids) with a re-sale sticker price below \$50,000 qualifies. All vehicles that receive the incentive must be registered under a single owner for at least one year from the date of receiving the incentive in order to qualify again.

Q: I don't live in Ontario. Do I qualify for the incentive?

A: No. This incentive is only available to Ontario residents. This decision rests with the funder.

Q: Why the cut off at \$50,000?


A: We want to help consumers who might not otherwise be able to purchase an EV. This decision rests with the funder.

Q: How will I find a used EV?

A: There are many classifieds websites that can help you browse used EVs in your area, including autoTRADER, Kijiji Auto, CarGurus and EVGenius. You can also send your preferences to Plug'n Drive at mycustomEV@plugndrive.ca. We will then forward them to a licensed used EV dealer that will do their best to find your perfect match.

Q: If I purchase my EV from a private seller, am I still eligible for the incentive?

A: Yes. Though you must still provide the relevant documentation (proof of purchase, proof of ownership and proof of insurance) to qualify.



Q: I am currently leasing an EV, but my lease is up for renewal. Do I qualify for the incentive?

A: Yes. Note, that extending or renewing your lease does not qualify. You must buy the car to receive the incentive.

Q: If I take over someone else's lease, do I qualify for the incentive?

A: No. Cars that are still on lease do not qualify. In order to receive the incentive, you must buy a used electric car.

Seminar

Q: How do I register for a seminar?

A: Visit plugndrive.gosignmeup.com to register for upcoming seminar dates and locations.

Q: What is the seminar all about?

A: Basics on the environmental and economic benefits of EVs, how to decide whether a fully electric or plug-in hybrid electric car is for you and things to consider when shopping for a used EV.

Q: If someone else is attending the seminar with me, but is not buying a used EV, do they still need to register?

A: Yes. We would like to know the expected attendance for each seminar, so that we can prepare materials and seating appropriately.

General Program Questions

Q: When does the program run?

A: The program runs from April 14 – September 30, 2019. It may be extended if funding continues to be available.

Q: Who is funding this?
